Jordan River Game Make a masking-tape line for the Jordan River. Play the game "Red rover, red rover, let [child's name] come over." Tell children when they hear their name, they should pretend they are going to the Jordan River. You will tell them how to come over (e.g., bunny hop, skip, jump, bear crawl, giant steps). When everyone is at the "Jordan," talk about Jesus' Baptism and also about God making us His children in Baptism. He calls us by name. We belong to Him.
